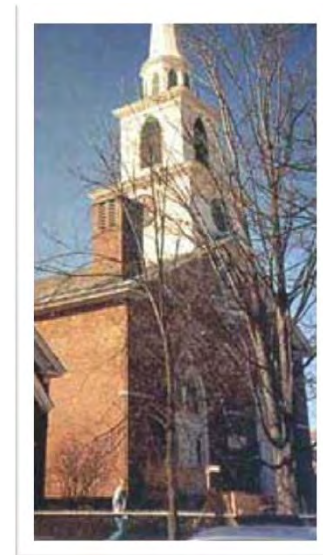

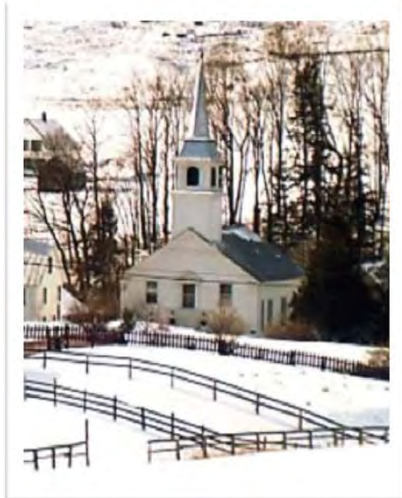

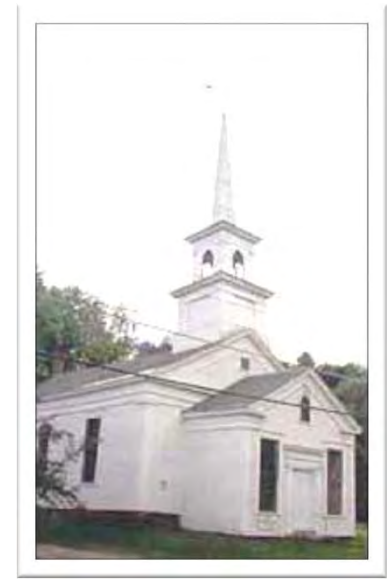

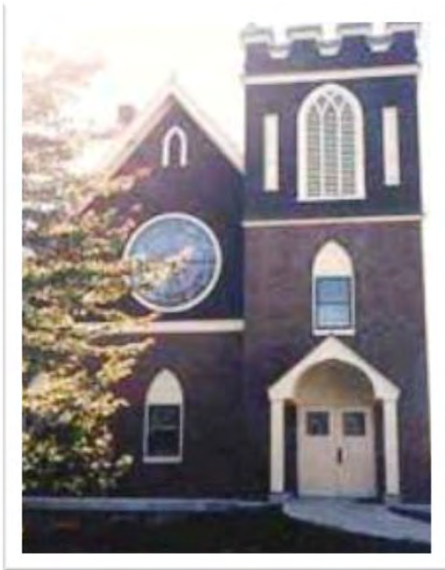

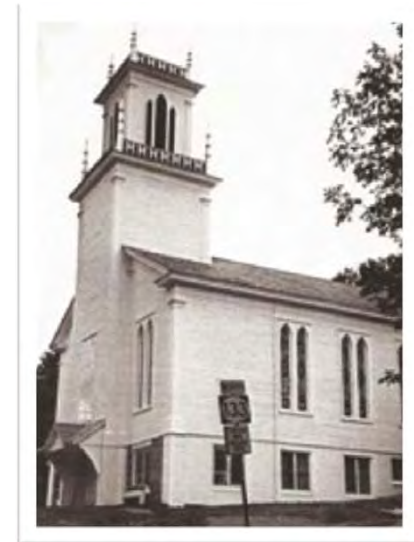

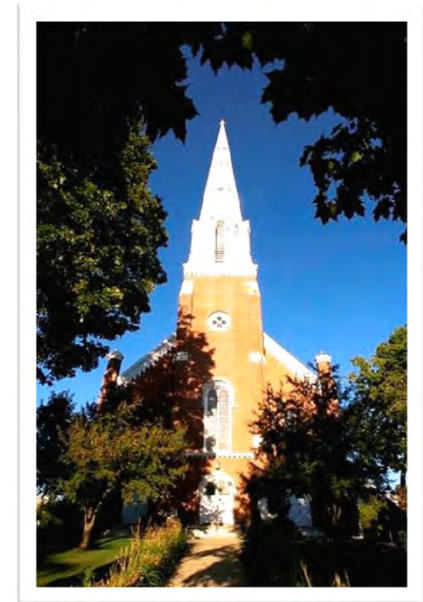

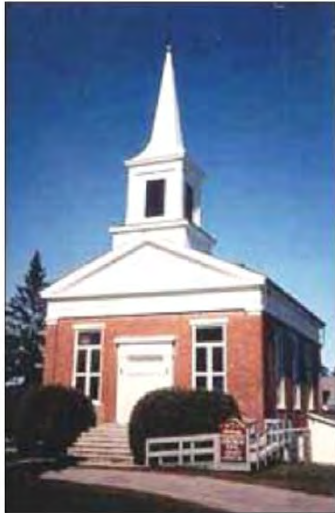

Federated and Dual Aligned churches meet the tithe goal at 5%.

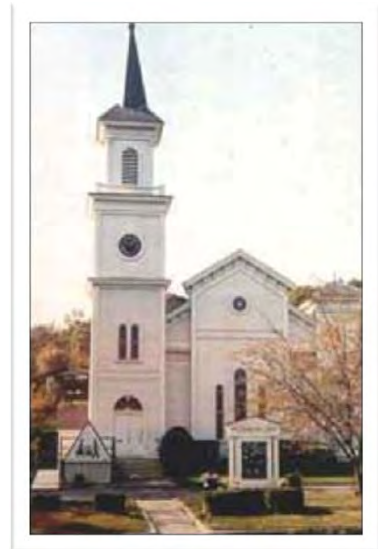

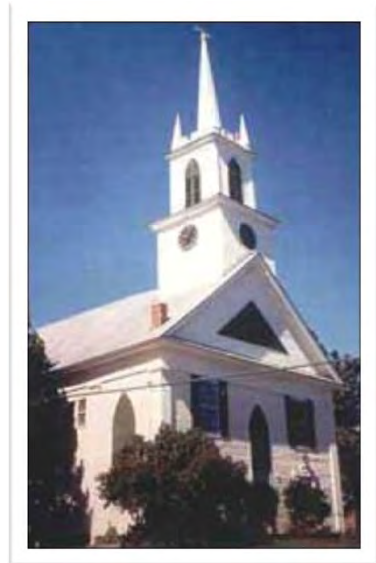

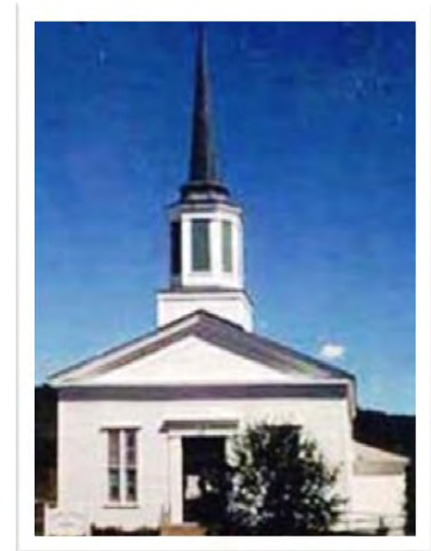
