Synod Reflection
General Synod 31: Make Glad

At General Synod 31, streams of individuals marched from the Baltimore Convention Center to the Federal Building in Baltimore in support of Guillermo Morales, an asylum seeker from El Salvador. Those streams formed the river that makes glad the city of God. Although General Synod had many highlights, including the election of Traci Blackmon as Executive Minister for Justice and Witness Ministries, the passage of a resolution for economic justice that I co-sponsored, and inspiring worship, workshops, and fellowship, the one highlight that will stand out over time is that stream of individuals making glad the city of God by marching against the oppression of the resident alien who lives amongst us.

Mr. Morales came to the United States twelve years ago seeking asylum. Somehow he missed his asylum hearing. It could be for any of a number of reasons: the asylum notice was never sent, or it went to the wrong address, or Mr. Morales didn't understand it, and I am sure that he didn't have an attorney advising him. So without any followup, Mr. Morales lived in Annapolis for twelve years, working as a carpenter, creating the chicken sculptures that grace downtown Annapolis in the same way that fiberglass moose grace downtown Bennington, raising his family and becoming a grandfather. Recently, a federal judge denied Mr. Morales' petition for a hearing to determine his asylum status, and he is currently being detained by US immigration officials.

As I listened to the speakers, I remebered a similar miscarriage of justice that occurred in a case I worked

One means of honoring Johanna Harpster is a donation to the on as a law student over 45 years ago. An aging, poor couple lost their home to a tax sale on a technicality. They stood ready to pay the back taxes. However, the technicality prevented them from doing so, and so they lost their home. That case and Mr. Morales' case demonstrate that too often our laws do not achieve justice. Instead of deportation for being in technical violation of our immigration laws, Mr. Morales should be allowed a hearing to demonstrate that he is a contributing member of our society, who should not be separated from his family and who should not be sent back to the danger that is El Salvador. It is more than time for our immigration laws to be reformed to achieve justice, rather than the injustice of blindly following technicalities.

The Center for Progressive Renewal is offering a fall semester online UCC History, Polity and Theology class beginning on September 6th and ending December 6th. The class has met the polity requirements of most Committees on Ministry in the UCC. It can be taken either for academic credit or simply to fulfill the polity requirement of Committees on Ministry. It has been accepted for credit in eight seminaries, including Union (NYC), Vanderbilt, Candler, Columbia, Eden, and Lancaster. It is included in the catalogs of both Union Theological Seminary and Lancaster Theological Seminary.
